**Biography:**

A/Prof Dinger is the Head of Clinical Genomics and Genome Informatics at the Garvan Institute of Medical Research. Prior to his position at the Garvan Institute, A/Prof. Dinger led the Cancer Genomics and Transcriptomics at the University of Queensland Diamantina Institute. Marcel received his PhD from the University of Waikato in 2003. While undertaking his PhD, Marcel founded an informatics company that produced a series of highly successful products and services. In 2005, he resumed his academic career with a prestigious New Zealand Foundation for Research Science and Technology Postdoctoral Fellowship to join Professor Mattick's group at the Institute for Molecular Bioscience at The University of Queensland to study the role of long noncoding RNAs in mammalian development and disease. In 2009, he was awarded an NHMRC Career Development Award and a Queensland Government Smart Futures Fellowship.
